

International Mountain Guide Climbing Championship 2026 in Berchtesgaden

4–5 December 2026 | Berchtesgaden

Two days dedicated to climbing, the international mountain guide community and the traditional customs of Berchtesgaden: The **International Mountain Guide Climbing Championship 2026** brings together mountain guides from different countries for a sporting competition and an opportunity to meet and exchange experiences in Berchtesgaden.

In addition to the qualification rounds and finals, participants can look forward to a varied social programme featuring an Asado barbecue, live music and traditional Berchtesgaden Advent customs.

Friday, 4 December 2026

09:00 | Admission & Introduction to the Programme by VDBS and IVBV

Admission for participants and official introduction to the programme and the individual events by **VDBS and IVBV**.

10:00–18:00 | Qualification

Start of the qualification rounds of the International Mountain Guide Climbing Championship.

The qualification provides sufficient time for the individual starts and forms the basis for the final rounds on the following day.

From 18:00 | Get-together & Evening Event at the Climbing Hall

After the first day of competition, the evening continues in a relaxed and informal atmosphere. Participants, accompanying guests and spectators are invited to gather at the climbing hall.

The evening programme includes:

- **Fire bowl** and a relaxed get-together
- **Asado** – barbecue over an open fire
- **Live music**
- Drinks and food
- Socialising and exchanging experiences within the international mountain guide community

An evening where friendship, meeting new people and a shared passion for the mountains take centre stage alongside the competition.

Saturday, 5 December 2026

09:00 | Continuation of the Qualification

The International Mountain Guide Climbing Championship continues on Saturday morning.

The remaining qualification rounds will be completed and the **eight best finalists** will be determined.

09:00–12:00 | Qualification Rounds

The final opportunity for participants to secure a place in the finals.

12:00–14:00 | Competition Break & Preparation for the Finals

Break for participants and spectators, followed by preparation and restructuring of the climbing routes for the decisive final rounds.

From 14:00 | Women's & Men's Finals

The sporting highlight of the International Mountain Guide Climbing Championship: The best mountain guides from the qualification rounds compete against each other on the final routes.

This is where the decision will be made as to who will claim the title of **International Mountain Guide Climbing Champion 2026 in Berchtesgaden**.

16:00 | Award Ceremony

Joint award ceremony for the women's and men's competitions, honouring the best participants and officially concluding the sporting part of the championship.
